

# Region VI Track & Field

## Field Event Judge Instructions

For most of you, this is review, but it is sometimes helpful to review things. Please read the instructions/guidelines below and follow them during the judging of your event.

### High Jump:

Use these symbols/Letters:

O = Successful attempt

X = Unsuccessful attempt

P = Passed (did not make attempt)

### Throws/Horizontal Jumps

F = Foul (no need to be more specific)

P = Passed (did not make attempt)

If attempt was recorded, enter distance in easy-to-read numerals.

- Be especially careful about your numerals 1, 4, 7 and 9, as sometimes it is quite difficult for me to distinguish between them.
- Putting a line through your 7's is helpful, as is putting a serif (horizontal bottom line) on your 1's.
- Make sure that the loops on your 9's are nice and round, and that the enclosed portions of your 4's have sharp angles.
- If the attempt is to the inch, with no fractions, do not record a fraction of “%” with the distance.

### Measurements

Discus – to nearest, lesser inch

Throws/Horizontal Jumps – to nearest, lesser ¼ inch.

### Preliminaries and Finals

In the 3A events at Region Championships, there are only finals. Athletes take four throws each.

If you are running a 4A event with preliminaries and finals, conduct three throws in the preliminaries.

*If there is only one flight and you are running preliminaries and finals:*

- after the three preliminary attempts, select the athletes with the eight best performances in the preliminary round to advance to the finals.
- re-order the athletes according to their best performances in the preliminaries, with the athlete with the best performance listed last, the athlete with the next-best performance listed next-to-last, etc.
- record the names and their best qualifying effort on the appropriate “Field Event Final” recording sheet, and conduct the last three throws using the “Field Event Final” recording sheet

*If there is more than one flight of preliminaries and you are running preliminaries and finals*

- after the three preliminary attempts, select the athletes with the eight best performances in the preliminary round to advance to the finals.
- re-order the athletes according to their best performances in the preliminaries, with the athlete with the best performance listed last, the athlete with the next-best performance listed next-to-last, etc.
- record the names and their best qualifying effort on the appropriate “Field Event Final” recording sheet, and conduct the last three throws using the “Field Event Final” recording sheet

### Other Information to Record:

Put your name and the names of the other officials on the recording sheet

Record the time your event started and the time each flight finished

### When Your Event Concludes

Immediately bring your recording sheets from both preliminaries and finals to the officials trailer and inform the Track & Field Meet Manager computer operator that your event is complete and you are dropping off the recording sheets.
